
# Example COGS with 501(c)(3) Designation

- 6. Western Chester County COG




### Benefits of 501(c)(3)

- Foundation Support
- Tax Deductible Gifts from Individuals
- Corporate Support
  - Event Support/Sponsorship
  - Volunteer Programs
  - United Way
- PA Sales Tax Exemption
- PA Games of Chance License
  - Raffles, Pools, 50/50 Drawings, Race Nights.
  - Charitable organizations with questions about licensure for small games of chance should contact their local county treasurer.




### Benefits of 501(c)(3)

  - COVID 19 ARPA Whole House Repairs




## Costs and Disadvantages of 501(c)(3)

- IRS Form 990
- Pennsylvania Audit Requirements
- <u>Limitations on Political Activity</u>
- Unrelated Business Income
   Limitations
- <u>Directors and Officers Liability</u>
   Insurance
- Private Inurement and Excess
   Benefit Transactions
- Might Not Get Sales Tax or Real Estate Tax Exemption




### Alternatives to 501(c)(3)

- Remain anUnincorporatedAssociation
- Establish <u>Fiscal</u>
   <u>Sponsorship Relationship</u>
   with Existing Nonprofit
- Incorporate a New,
   Affiliated Entity to be
   501(c)(3).




#### Summary of Steps to Becoming 501(c)(3)

- Incorporate in Pennsylvania
- Seek Tax-Exempt Status
   from the IRS
- Register with Bureau of Charitable Organizations
- Seek PA Sales Tax
   Exemption
- Seek Property Tax
   Exemption



## Incorporate in Pennsylvania

- File Articles of Incorporation
   w/PA Dept. of State.
- Bylaws
- Elect Directors and Officers
- Adopt Conflict of Interest
   Policy
- Formational Resolution(s)
- Advertise Incorporation




# Seek Tax Exempt Status from IRS (2 Options)

#### • IRS Form 1023 EZ

- Much Shorter (Online) Application
- <u>Eligibility Worksheet</u> (Budget Under \$50K)
- Statement of Purpose
- NTEE Code
- Board Members and Officer Information
- Approx. 6 Weeks to Get Designation Letter
- \$275 Filing Fee


#### • IRS Form 1023

- Lengthier (Online) Application
- Board Members Bios, Narrative
   Description of Activities, Pro-Forma
   Budgets
- 12-18 Months to Get Designation Letter
- \$600 Filing Fee
